

National Careers Institute Advisory Board Communiqué

The National Careers Institute Advisory Board held a meeting on Wednesday 18 August 2021.

This meeting was attended by the Hon Stuart Robert MP, Minister for Employment, Workforce, Skills, Small and Family Business (the Minister) at the invitation of the Chair. The Minister noted the important leadership role of the National Careers Institute (NCI) in the careers sector, particularly in regard to providing better, simplified career related information.

The draft NCI Strategic Communications Framework was presented, which will serve as an overarching communications policy to provide guidance and support across the NCI when developing communications for specific projects or interacting with stakeholders.

Following a presentation on proposed updates for the YourCareer website, the Board complimented the NCI for the modern website design which is anticipated to be launched in 2022.

The Board hosted an external guest, Ms Kit McMahon, who presented her analysis on vocational pricing through a gender equity lens.

The National Careers Institute Advisory Board is next due to meet on 14 October 2021.
