Our Services

- We will maintain a regular presence in local schools across Alice Springs to raise awareness of your industry and opportunities to students.
- Collaboration on industry information sessions and expos that include parents and youth entering the workforce.
- We can also facilitate cultural awareness training for you and your staff to ensure culturally safe workplaces for Indigenous employees.
- Using our tailored and personalised online-based research tool to match the best candidates for your vacancies.
- We tailor vocational training to meet your business requirements with our own Registered Training Organisation, Bamara Education and Training, and our network of other training partners.
- Trialing new employees through the Australian government Youth Jobs PaTH service, which includes funding support for your business.
- Six months of personal post-placement mentoring and support for you and your new employees for extra peace of mind.
- Access to Government funding, including wage subsidies for eligible new employees.
