- Give you access to assistance and resources 24/7 via Employable Me, our online platform where you can post your job vacancies and find potential candidates who are ready to work.
- Providing local training in Goodna, Ipswich, and Inala ensuring access to local job seekers.
- Building employability skills focussed on the local labour market. In the Wivenhoe Employment Region, this may include jobs in highest growth and largest employing industries of Healthcare &

Social Assistance, Public Administration & Safety, Transport, Postal & Warehousing, Manufacturing, and Retail Trade.
