SEE will help you learn the skills you need to get the job you want by:

- improving your English, reading and writing skills, and
- improving your maths skills.

## Do you want to:

- be more confident about doing further study?
- build a better pathway to the job you want?
- improve the skills you already have?

SEE will help you find a job by improving your skills. It will also help with everyday tasks, like writing, filling in forms and reading to your child.

## Quick facts about SEE:

- it's free
- you can begin at your own level
- you can learn at your own pace
- you can still look for work or care for your family
- You can study full time or part time
- You can learn in a classroom or at home at your own pace supported by teachers
- you can study between 10 and 25 hours a week
- training is based on your future goals
- you can do work experience
