The Key Apprenticeship Program (KAP) is part of the Australian Government's *Future Made in Australia* plan to build a strong and skilled workforce for tomorrow. KAP supports eligible apprentices working in some of Australia's most in-demand jobs, helping you train, earn and grow in a sustainable and future focused career.

What's in it for apprentices?

From 1 July 2025, if you start or restart an apprenticeship in an eligible clean energy or housing construction occupation, you may be eligible to receive up to \$10,000 in direct financial support on top of your wage.

There are over 65 occupations listed as clean energy and/or housing construction on the <u>Australian</u> <u>Apprenticeships Priority List</u> to choose from.

Support for employers

Employers of KAP apprentices may also benefit from the Priority Hiring Incentive, receiving up to \$5,000 in financial support from the Australian Government.

- Full-time apprentices: \$2,000 at 6 months and \$3,000 at 12 months (full- time)
- Part-time apprentices: \$1,000 at 6 months and \$1,500 at 12 months (part-time)
