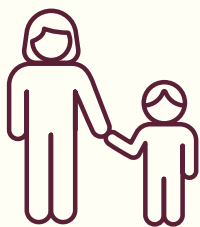

- Carer Payment



- Special Benefit.

Parent Pathways is also available for parents and carers who:



- don't receive certain support payments from the Australian Government



- are under 22 years old



- left school before finishing Year 12



- are from the Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander community.



Parent Pathways connects parents and carers with someone who can help them meet their goals.

- study or do training.
