
## Australian Skills Guarantee Eligibility checklist, Version 1.2

This checklist provides information about the eligibility requirements for the Australian Skills Guarantee (Skills Guarantee) Procurement Connected Policy (PCP).

### Eligibility Decision Flow



## YES – apply PCP Version 1 (1 July 2024)

The procurement is considered an **Eligible Project** for the Skills Guarantee PCP, and you should apply PCP Version 1.

If the eligible Construction project has an estimated individual value of \$100 million (GST inclusive) or more, it is a Flagship Construction Project with additional requirements.

Don't forget to include the relevant Model Clauses and targets in the Approach to Market documentation and Contract.

## YES – apply PCP Version 1.2 (1 Oct 2025)

The procurement is an **Eligible Project** for the Skills Guarantee PCP, and you should apply PCP Version 1.2.

If the eligible Construction project has an estimated individual value of \$100 million (GST inclusive) or more, it is a Flagship Construction Project with additional requirements.

If the eligible ICT project has an estimated individual value of \$50 million (GST inclusive) or more, it is a High-Value ICT Project with additional requirements.

Don't forget to include the relevant Model Clauses and targets in the Approach to Market documentation and Contract.

#### NO

The procurement is **not considered an Eligible Project** for the Skills Guarantee PCP.

\* CPR 2.6 - 'The CPRs do not apply to the extent that an official applies measures determined by their Accountable Authority (or an official to whom the Accountable Authority delegates the power to determine such measures) to be necessary for the maintenance or restoration of international peace and security, to protect human health, for the protection of essential security interests, or to protect national treasures of artistic, historic or archaeological value.

# Skills Guarantee Procurement Connected Policy eligibility requirements

If your Approach to Market (ATM) was issued between 1 July 2024 and 30 September 2025, it will be subject to the Skills Guarantee PCP Version 1. If your ATM was issued from 1 October 2025, it will be subject to the Skills Guarantee PCP Version 1.2.

Relevant Entities may consider negotiating the application of the updated ICT targets outlined in the Skills Guarantee PCP Version 1.2 for eligible ATMs issued prior to 1 October 2025, where Contracts with Potential Suppliers are signed on or after that date.

- paid entry-level work on an eligible Major ICT Project or High-Value Project;
- Accredited Vocational Education and Training (VET) or Higher Education to obtain a qualification under the Australian Qualification Framework; and
- the employer formally committed to providing on the job training and support to complete their qualification.

Employment of an eligible Learning Worker undertaking:

- paid work on a Major ICT Project or High-Value ICT Project as an Apprentice or ICT Cadet, or
- paid work on a Major ICT Project or High-Value ICT Project as a Worker currently undertaking Accredited VET and/or Higher Education relevant to the employment and skills needs of the employer while employed on the Eligible Project, or
- paid work on a Major ICT Project or High-Value ICT Project as a Worker and currently undertaking or successfully completes a Microcredential relevant to the employment and skills needs of the employer while employed on the Eligible Project.
