We will develop a personalised Participation Plan with you that has practical steps to help you work towards achieving your goals!

The steps in your Participation Plan will include;

- Our one on one support through private appointments with your Consultant
- An activity that is specifically chosen to fit into your existing family routine and support your goal. This may include;

- Training or further study
- Computer literacy sessions
- Attending cultural groups or meetings
- Literacy or numeracy support sessions
