Looking for help with starting or growing your small business?

The Australian Government provides support to help you explore your business ideas, start a business, or grow your existing small business, through Workforce Australia Self-Employment Assistance.

The Self-Employment Assistance program is delivered in 51 regions across Australia, and provides:

- Exploring Self-Employment Workshops
- Business Plan Development
- Small Business Training courses
- Business Advice Sessions
- Business Health Checks
- Small Business Coaching.

To be eligible for Self-Employment Assistance you must:

- be at least 15 years of age (or 18 years of age to access Small Business Coaching)
- be an Australian citizen, or the holder of a permanent visa, or a nominated Visa Holder (including a New Zealand Special category Visa, Temporary Protection Visa Holder and a Safe Haven Visa Holder)
- not be undischarged bankrupt
