The Pacific Australia Labour Mobility (PALM) scheme is the Australian Government's integrated approach to Pacific labour mobility. As part of the transition to a consolidated PALM scheme for both short and long-term workers, a new IT system - the Pacific Australia Labour Mobility Information System (PALMIS) has been launched.

PALMIS aligns with new PALM scheme deed and guidelines requirements, and contains many new features to help streamline processes such as recruitments, mobilisations and incident reporting.

As a registered user of PALMIS, this email update will keep you informed of important system features and how to use them.

We intend to send this update weekly while PALMIS while we all get used to the new interfacing systems.

Finding information and training resources online

A <u>PALMIS resources page</u> is now available on the Department of Employment and Workplace Relations (DEWR) PALM scheme website page. We are continuously adding user information on this page so always refer to this page when looking for training and procedural information.

What's new?

We release new features and upgrades to PALMIS and the AE portal systems every 2 weeks to improve the user experience. When we release new features you will see release notes near the top of your screen on the AE portal. Please note some planned items of work may not yet be completed.

Upcoming development

The next release will occur on Thursday 5 October 2023. This release will focus on:

- Updating search for recruitment plans/work sites/labour market tests/hosts
- Providing the ability to copy previous accommodation plans
- Providing further enhancement for submitting incidents
- Ensuring further alignment between accommodation plans and guidelines requirements
- Enabling the ability to upload visa grant letters once granted
- Sending notification to employers once all worker documents available from IRD

How can I restrict access within the AE portal between different users?

The AE Portal has 2 user types: user and system administrator. There are no other role distinguishments. Approved employers are required to ensure their personnel meet deed requirements relating to privacy and security including that data is only used for the purpose of fulfilling its obligations under the deed.

We are considering further role and access differentiation for AE portal users in future releases.

Why does the deductions section use the term 'Net pay before tax'?

The purpose of the pay & deductions schedules is to assess two things:

- 1. the risk profile of the estimated net pay figure as compared to low pay thresholds; and
- 2. the nature of proposed deductions.

It is not a comprehensive salary or tax calculation that accounts for all possible taxation scenarios; it is designed to allow for simple administration of PALM Scheme requirements.

The specific calculation the system uses for 'Net pay before tax' is:

Gross pay = estimated hours per week x pay rate for role Total deductions = sum of all deductions Net pay before tax = gross pay – total deductions

This language does not populate through to letters of offer, it is to assist employers and PALM scheme staff.

I'm a former Pacific Labour Scheme employer. Why can't I see my historical accommodation plans and labour market tests in the portal?

These are being migrated, including manual data entry of legacy plans that were completed in hard copy. We expect these to be available within the AE portal by 6 October 2023.

Can I delete a user from the AE portal?

The approved employer primary contact must submit an enquiry through the AE portal to request we remove each user. The correspondence will be recorded and actioned on your behalf.

What does the colour coding mean for with the accommodation spaces requirements?

The space types will change colour based on their completion status.

Grey - it has yet to be created

Yellow - it is still missing information

Green - the information is acceptable

Can I remove accommodation plans?

Accommodation plans in the submitted state can now be withdrawn using the top right corner of the accommodation plan.

Tip of the week

Questions or concerns?

If you are unable to find something in the existing guidance about a specific issue, the best way to get help is to submit an enquiry through PALMIS and provide as much information as you can. This will be submitted to the relevant teams and will be escalated as needed.
